THE CLASS

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

CHECK PAYMENTS: Make checks payable to the Arts Council and include your child's name and school on the check and submit with your completed registration form to the instructor or front office.

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS: Payments can be made using Mastercard or Visa by registering online at www.HillcrestArts.com or by calling the Hillcrest Center for the Arts at 806-381-2747. American Express is accepted by phone payment only. Please turn in a registration form to the instructor or front office after paying online.

A partial waiver of payment will be considered in cases of financial hardship, please contact the Arts Council. Due to the low cost of the program, school calendar conflicts will not be made up unless the instructor's schedule permits.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

All interested students in grades 3, 4 and 5. Students must maintain class work and be responsible for any work missed during class.

BEHAVIOR STANDARDS

Music students are expected to conform to acceptable standards of behavior, just as in any other school activity. If a student displays unacceptable behavior, he/she will be warned and the parents will be phoned. If there is a second occurrence, the student will be sent back to classroom for the lesson. On the third instance, the student will be expelled from the strings music program. No make-up lessons or refunds will be given for behavior-related incidences.

PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

Students in the early years of instrumental music study need parental encouragement, involvement and guidance. At least 30 minutes per day five days a week is needed for practice. Parents and students should discuss the best time and place for daily practice so that the student is not distracted by other activities. Private lessons are highly encouraged.

INSTRUMENTS

Once you have decided on your instrument (violin, viola, cello or bass), students and parents are responsible for providing instruments and equipment. Supplemental material will be provided by the instructor at no extra charge. Students may purchase or rent instruments from any of the following music stores:
